Circobaya is a Spanish theatre group composed of two actors, Charo Amaya and Javier González. Circobaya has been working professionally on theatre and circus from more than 10 years and runs its show Vaya Circo since 2004, awarded Best Show in Tres Días de Farándula Festival (2013, Gran Canaria, Spain).

They have been part of different troupes and groups, as Cruzando el Charco (2007), a circus collective, or the award-winning Tres puntos y aparte (BEST SHOW AUDIENCE AWARD in 12th Street Theatre Festival, Palencia, Spain; BEST SHOW AND BEST ACTOR JURY PRIZE in Noctívagos Festival, 2011)

During its artistic career, Circobaya has made several tours, visiting México, Chile, Croatia, France, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Jordan, Palestine or RD Congo.

In 2014 it has started a new show, El viaje de Miércoles (Wednesday's Trip), directed by Michelle Man and Hernán Gené

Synopsis

Matilde, a restless little rascal not much more than four feet tall, enjoys turning good-natured and peaceful Romero upside down with her pranks and her crazy ideas, even though he is more than 6 feet tall and is three times her weight.

The performance starts; Matilde keeps running wildly everywhere on stage, managing to leave Romero at the end of his rope, and in consequence, making the audience laugh.

In this street performance show fun is guaranteed!

It is a participative show where grown-ups and youngsters can get the best out of complex acrobatics, juggling, dangerous equilibristics and especially lots of humour.

“What a circus” was premiered in 2005 in the street theatre festival of Laguna de Duero and it is still in action, having done more than five hundred performances in around ten different countries ... and situations.
